IUPAP YOUNG SCIENTIST PRIZE IN PLASMA PHYSICS 2015

International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP) Commission on Plasma Physics C16 Young Scientist Prize recognizes exceptional achievement in the study of plasma physics by scientists at a relatively early stage of their career.

The recipient must be no more than eight years post PhD (excluding career interruptions) by the deadline of the competition, and is expected to have displayed significant achievement and exceptional promise for future achievement in an area of plasma physics.

The Prize will consist of 1,000 Euro and a Medal and Certificate. The Prize will be presented at the 2015 International Conference on the Physics of Ionized Gases (ICPIG), in Romania 26th- 31st July 2015.

Nominations should include reasons for nomination on one page, a short citation and CV including all publications and send to Prof. [Lin-Ni Hau](#), Chair of IUPAP C16, National Central University, Taiwan. (Email: linnihau@gmail.com)
