COMMISSION ON PHYSICS FOR DEVELOPMENT (C13)

Report for the Council and Commission Chairs Meeting, October 2011) Kennedy Reed (Chair)

Meetings

C13 has held three meetings in three years (August, 2009, August 2010, and August 2011). All three meetings were hosted by ICTP in Trieste and were well attended with active participation of 10 to 13 of the regular Commission members and two or more of the 4 Associate members - as well as guests from other IUPAP units and other international organizations working in Physics for Development.

Collaboration with C20 on Computational Physics Schools in Africa

In 2008 C13 initiated a collaboration with C20 and ICTP to organize a Computational Physics School Series in Africa. The first of these schools, held July 19-30, 2010 in South Africa, was very successful. C20 and C13 members successfully engaged other major sponsors - including ICTP, NITheP, SAIP, NRF. APS-DCOMP, and ICMR in Santa Barbara, USA. (See attached report.) Articles on this inaugural school were published in Nature Physics [Nature Physics, 6, 830 (2010)], and Physics Today [Phys. Today 64, 28 (2011)]. The next school in the series will be held in 2012 at Moi University in Eldoret, Kenya. Members of C13 and C20 have been working with the local organizers on arrangements. Our joint efforts have already resulted in substantial funding commitments from various sources for the 2012 school. This school series is a significant undertaking and has been a major accomplishment for C13 and our collaborators.

Visiting Scientist Program

C13 began and completed work on developing an IUPAP Visiting Scientist Program that will help research groups or institutions in developing countries benefit from interactions with experts in other countries. Workshop in Brazil

The C13 Chair made an invited presentation on C13 activities in a Workshop entitled "World Cooperation In Physics: Bridging the Gap". The workshop was held on June 5, 2011 in connection with a meeting of the Brazilian Physical Society at Iguazu Falls, Brazil.

African Physical Society

C13 was a sponsor of the January 2010 LAM9/EBASI7 Conference in Dakar, Senegal that included the launch of the continent-wide African Physical Society. A C13 member

was the principal organizer of the Conference and is vice-president of the new African Physical Society.

New IUPAP Member Application

Following the recommendation and encouragement of C13, Kenya has applied for Category C IUPAP membership. We expect this request to be discussed by the Council at the meeting in October 2011.
